Indoor visitation policy- Updated January 2022

- Visitors **do not** need to schedule their visitation. Preferred visiting hours are 9 a.m. until 8p.m. (with the exception of meal times.) Exceptions may be made by making arrangements prior to visitation.
- All visitors are to use entrance D5. Temperature check and screening are required for each person at every visit and paperwork must be filled out in full.
- Visitors are to be greeted by staff at D5 to make sure they are properly screened and proper mask usage. No visitors are to be given the entrance code.
- Visits may be held in the resident's room, patio area, or other socially distanced areas. Visitors are asked to not spend time near or around other residents in the facility.
- No more than 4 visitors are preferred at one time. You may call about making arrangements for exceptions.
- All visitors, regardless of vaccination status, must wear a properly fitting surgical/procedural style or N95 mask at all times.
- Visitation will not be permitted during resident meal times unless approval is obtained prior to visitation and instructions are followed.
- Facility staffing levels and covid-19 status within the facility can cause visitation to be suspended immediately.
- Visitors are strongly encouraged to be fully vaccinated prior to visitation.
- No food or drinks are permitted to be consumed by visitors or residents visiting with unvaccinated visitors- due to mask policy.
- If you are not feeling well for any reason, please do not visit until you are well.
- If you have had direct contact with someone who has tested positive for COVID-19 within the past 10 days, please delay your visit until after the CDC recommended quarantine time has passed or after you have tested negative for COVID-19.
- Failure to comply with the core principles of COVID-19 infection prevention can result
 in someone not being allowed to visit or someone being asked to leave the premises.
