

Their first date? A boat ride. Mary Ellon brought along her friend Edna “just in case.”

Mary Ellon Inman was born on May 9, 1926, in Chadburn, North Carolina, the oldest of three children: Younger sister Vista Lee (nicknamed Dink) and baby brother James Edward. Sadly, James passed away a year after his birth. Mary Ellon and “Dink” remain close to this day; they speak EVERY day at 3pm to check on each other.

Growing up during the Depression, life was at time hard for the Inman family. Dad was a farmer and worked odd jobs in factories. When one job ended, he always seemed to find another, however, that meant uprooting the family and moving to a new city. Ultimately they moved about 15 times, Mary Ellon enjoyed school and always maintained good grades, no matter what school it was at the time.

After graduation, Mary Ellon found employment in the payroll department of a fabric factory in Fayetteville, where the workers spun the thread used to make towels and sheets. She recalls the factory always being very hot. One busy day, she and her co-workers were talking about a recent movie with good reviews, “For Whom the Bell Tolls” starring Gary Cooper and Ingrid Bergman. Mary Ellon decided to check out the movie that evening. At that time, theatres were always crowded, with people waiting in long lines. The movie would play in a continuous loop, so as people exited, others entered, meaning that you would at times walk in during the middle of the movie. Mary Ellon wasn’t the only one waiting alone in a long line. Robert Boyle, who was currently stationed at Fort Bragg Army base, had a friend cancel at the last minute, so he was in line behind Mary Ellon. As two people exited, Mary Ellon and Robert entered, together, though they did not sit by each other. After the movie, Robert followed Mary Ellon to the bus stop. She was in a hurry to catch the bus and did not have time to talk, so Robert talked to her through the window, asking for her phone number. Not having a phone at home, she gave him the number of fabric factory. He called the next day. It was very uncharacteristic to be so forward, but there was something about Mary Ellon; he wanted to get to know her better. Their first date? A boat ride. Mary Ellon brought along her friend Edna “just in case.”

After dating for six weeks, Robert proposed before leaving for Guam. Over the next year, the two wrote letters back and forth, really getting to know each other. When Bob returned to his hometown in Pittsburgh after the war, Mary Ellon began to experience doubts about marriage. Determined to clear away these doubts, Bob immediately drove to Fayetteville and did clear away those doubts. The two lovebirds married on May 9, 1946 (her birthday), moving to Pittsburgh and living with Bob’s parents to save money. Bob enrolled at the University of Pittsburgh to study engineering, and Mary Ellon landed a very good job at West Penn Power, earning enough to support herself and Bob while he attended college. The couple welcomed their first child, Marianne, in 1950, and five years later, John Robert joined the family.

In 1965, the Inman family moved to Warren, OH, where Bob had accepted an engineering job. Mary Ellon enjoyed her time at home raising the kids, however, once grown, she once again entered the work force, working at the Warren Furnace Company, then at Trumbull County Children’s Services, retiring after 19 years to help with her grandson, Matthew. His mother, Marianne, accepted a wonderful job opportunity in Solon, and because Matthew was a senior and doing very well in school, she did not want to uproot him. So he lived with Bob and Mary Ellon his senior year, ultimately graduating the co-valedictorian. Bob and Mary Ellon enjoyed every minute of their time together – traveling, antiquing and bowling. In 2005, they sold their house in Warren and moved to Solon. In 2012, another move – this time to Florida. Sadly, Bob passed away in 2015. Mary Ellon moved back to Solon and in 2021, moved to an independent apartment here at Anna Maria. She has made many friends and enjoys the variety of activities. There’s something for everyone here on our campus. May God continue to bless Mary Ellon with good health and happiness.




