## From our Family to Yours....Merry Christmas and a Happy and Blessed New Year 2020!



We want to thank you for a wonderful 2019. From a business standpoint, we were very busy on all fronts this year. Census and demand for all setting (skilled nursing, assisted and independent living, home care, and therapy) was extremely high. Our best advertisement is always word of mouth, as most referrals to our Campus come from a family member or close friend that had a positive experience at the Campus of Anna Maria.

### As we close out the year, we'd like to share some additional information on "what's happening" here on our campus.

We are finally completing the remodeling project in Arborview, though the new furniture won't arrive until next month. The changes include a new color palette, ceiling replacements, new handrails, new dining room, light fixtures, carpet/flooring, and furniture. The addition of new activity/dementia stations will be completed in the near future. We've also added a new patio adjacent to the back entrance in the assisted living area. This will be a wonderful outdoor space for our families and residents to gather. Two of the four great rooms in Norwood "A" and "B" have received much-needed attention with new paint, carpeting, furniture, and new entrance doors with automatic openers. A therapy room in Norwood "B" will be constructed next year, consisting of a small, outpatient therapy gym where residents can receive physical and occupational therapy services. New outdoor lighting has been installed all around the Campus. The Kensington at Anna Maria building boasts a newly-remodeled front lobby area as well as new lighting throughout the building.

Potential projects for 2020 include creating two small studio apartments in Norwood "B," further enhancements to the other "B" great rooms, new flooring in the dining area of the Southwest unit at Kensington as well as new dementia life stations.

As part of our overall Emergency Preparedness plan, the Campus of Anna Maria will be implementing a WENS system in 2020, which is an automated phone call or text to families and/or staff in the event of an emergency where immediate communication could be initiated. We are also considering Campus-wide security cameras.

So again, thank you for your support, and we look forward to meeting and exceeding your expectations in the new year, 2020.




